Registered Practical Nurse – Telehomecare

This full-time position is responsible for communicating, assessing and facilitating a patient's telehomecare health services needs. As part of the health care team you will assist the patient, their caregivers and families to participate in their care planning.

Key accountabilities of this position include:

- Complete initial patient intake information.
- Promote and plan for patient independence and self-management of chronic and complex issues.
- Assess, negotiate, problem-solve telehomecare equipment.
- Determine patient requirements and balances the person's needs and choice with appropriate resources in a fiscally responsible manner.
- Counsel, negotiate, educate, and assist the patient in managing risk.
- Advocate with family, hospital staff and other care providers on behalf of the patient to promote patient choice and self-management.
- Coordinate telehomecare equipment.

Your qualifications and experience will include:

- Registered Practical Nurse, in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario.
- Strong knowledge base and previous experience working with patients with complex chronic issues including CHF, COPD, diabetes and mental health.
- Knowledge of primary care and community resources.
- Effective interpersonal, communication and computer skills.
- Ability to communicate in French or other languages an asset.
